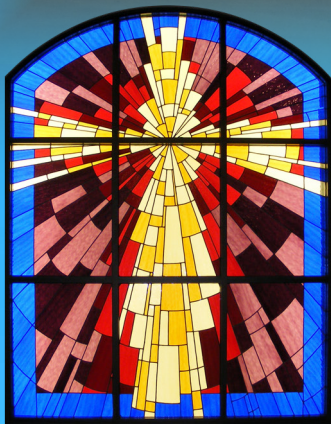

Victory has many opportunities for you to learn and grow in a small group setting on Sunday morning at 9:30 AM. We encourage you to try them out and find the one that fits you.

SAM Class

This is the class where you discover what Jubilee is all about. We fellowship, sing and study God's Word in a comfortable setting. This is designed for age 55 and above.

Adult Classes

These classes seek to answer most of your questions about our foundational truths. We go much deeper into the word of God, and the goal is to strengthen your foundations of faith in Christ.

•The Bereans

Digging deeper into God's Word and how it relates to the current events. Led by Anthony Harden.

•Open Door

Understanding God's Word through an adult study of various books of the Bible. Led by Jamie Barker.

•Ladies Class

Ladies with a heart for Bible study, prayer and seeking the Lord's plan for their lives are welcome. Bring a hungry heart and be refreshed as we study God's Word together.

•Connect

God values family relationships. He wants you to be part of a community where people support and encourage you. Come learn more of how to value your spouse and each other the way God intended.

eleVate

College is a starting point to the future. This class is designed to serve individuals who have graduated from high school and are attending college. Don't worry about breakfast, we have you covered.

Senior High

This class is designed to be a setting where students have the ability to ask questions and share from their own lives in order to grow in holiness.

Junior High

This class is the starting point for the VSM Student Ministry. Middle school students gather to learn and discuss various truths from God's Word as they seek to be difference makers in their generation.

Pre K-5th Grade

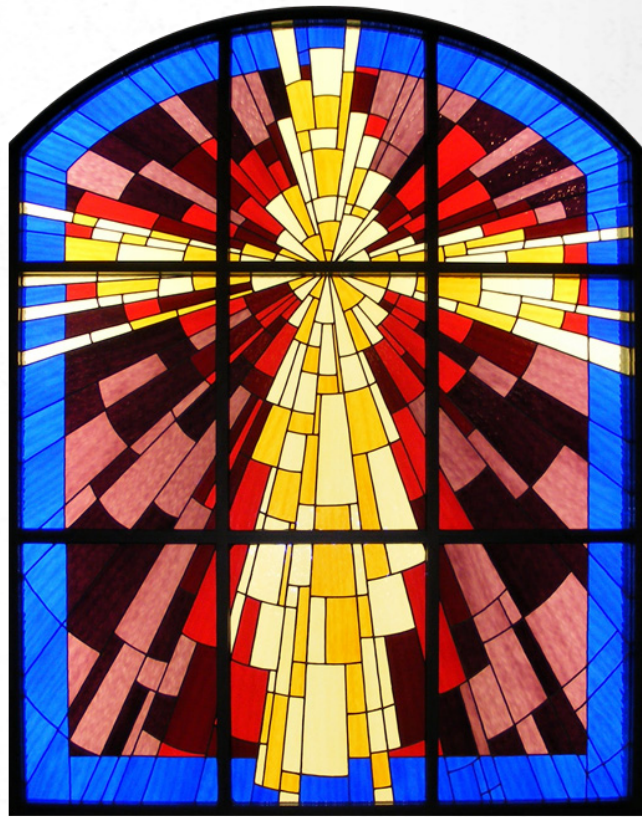
