

Awana is an international, Biblecentered ministry that provides local churches with the training and materials needed to effectively minister to children. Since its inception in 1950, Awana is now being used in over 12,000 churches nationwide.

The goal of Awana is to give boys and girls the chance to know, love and serve God. While this goal is one we take very seriously, the atmosphere at our meetings is anything but that. We believe that by making each club night fun, the clubbers will not only want to learn, but will want to bring others with them. Game time, theme nights and section madness are just a few of the things that make Awana exciting and keep your children coming back for more.

Each club night is divided into three segments:

1) Game Time – promotes teamwork and good sportsmanship.

2) Handbook Time – emphasizes memorizing and understanding key Bible verses, then rewarding the clubbers achievements.

3) Council Time – a practical Bible lesson is presented.



2 year olds (Must be 2 by August 1st)

Puggles is a one-year program that is built around four precepts: God made everything, God saw that it was good, God is love and give thanks. Each week features a theme around one of the precepts and related core verses. Take-home cards help parents reinforce lesson concepts in simple ways throughout the week. They also encourage the whole family to learn about God together.

Parents: If you plan to enroll your child in Puggles, we ask that you stay at the church and attend the Adult Bible Study at 7:00.



3-4 year olds (Must be 3 by August 1st)

Cubbies is a two-year program designed to teach basic biblical truths. This process begins at home as clubbers complete parent-child activities provided in their handbooks and memorize verses geared for their age group.

Then, each week, games, puppets, crafts, awards and other activities are used to transform our preschool program into a lively weekly experience where fun and learning go hand in hand.



Sparks is a three-year program that builds on the material taught in our preschool clubs. The curriculum takes kids on a journey through the entire Bible while giving unsaved boys and girls regular opportunities to hear the gospel and come to faith in Jesus Christ. Each year, Sparks clubbers will explore the biographies of people of the Bible from a new portion of Scripture, then memorize Bible verses and complete activities that reinforce lessons learned.



3rd - 5th Grades (6th Grade Optional)

T & T is a three-year program designed to teach clubbers the truth of God's word and train them to follow Christ in their daily lives. Our goal is that many of today's young people will become tomorrow's church leaders. The first two handbooks in T & T teach clubbers that salvation in Christ is the Ultimate Adventure, while the last two handbooks prepare them for the Ultimate Challenge that lies ahead. Each handbook answers four questions about God and the Bible that are frequently asked. Clubbers learn eight answers to each of these questions along with verses to back up these answers.
